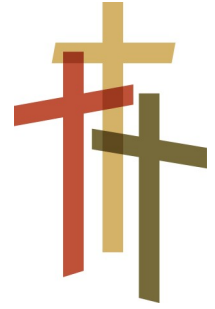


CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) PARISHES CONTINUITY PLAN

FTW Benefice as at 20th March 2020



We are following Government and National Church advice as the situation develops.

CHURCH EVENTS AND SERVICES ARE CANCELLED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

Occasional Offices ie. Funerals, Weddings, and Baptisms, which are already booked, can, at the moment go ahead but special measures apply. Clergy and Church Wardens will keep abreast of communications coming from the Diocese, National Church and Public Health England. And you will be informed as and when we know more.

We have a plan in place to ensure as far as possible the continued mission and ministry of parishes, and the maintenance of the critical ongoing business of the parish.

The Rector, Revd Judy Hunt, with the support of the Church Wardens of all three parishes, have responded to the need to prepare for the current scenario of Coronavirus being a pandemic.

The Rector's nominated deputies are Revd Elaine Atack (until 12th April 2020) and Revd Sue Armstrong. Mrs Jane Rylands (Licensed Lay Minister/Reader) will fulfil this role should all the clergy be unwell or needing to self-isolate.

The Rector, or her nominated deputy, will provide a channel for regular communication, by email or phone, with the Rural / Area Dean and Archdeacon as requested.

A list of key people available for ministry, including occasional offices and pastoral care, will be kept by Clergy, Church Wardens and in the Parish Office.

A leaflet will be available for church members and the wider community about how to contact people if in need of a phone call, a visit (unless visiting is not recommended) or other pastoral care. The leaflet will also include how to access some spiritual resources – on line for those able to do so, or posted/delivered to them if not.

For the duration of the outbreak please maintain good hygiene routines and follow governmental advise.
