PASTORAL LETTER

For the Church, November is the month of remembering. It begins with All Saints' Day (to commemorate all the saints who don't have a feast day to themselves), straight onto All Souls' Day (to remember all those we love but see no longer), to Remembrance, through two weeks stuffed full of saints' festivals, finally ending with Christ the King (where we remember that Christ is our one true ruler and leader).

Of course, for many people, Remembrance is the most significant day out of all of these, and for everyone it is one of the most important days of the Church year. We consciously turn off the 'auto-pilot' mindset which is all too easy to slip into when we live in a democracy, and we give thanks to those who made the ultimate sacrifice so that we could have our freedoms. But our remembering is not just recalling men's names, ages, and battles they fought in. To remember is to re-member: to reclaim someone from the past, and to keep them as a member of our community. By re-membering, we stop them from drifting into the mists of time, where they disappear into vagueness and obscurity. We bring them back into our lives, deliberately, and thank them for what they did by keeping them as a whole human being, rather than reducing them to their actions or their contributions.

November, as the month of remembering, encapsulates the Christian message: that all of these people - the soldiers, the saints, the people in our lives - are all worth remembering, because each one of them was made out of God's love. Each one of them was precious, and each one of them was fearfully and wonderfully made. And as we take the time this month to re-member them, we do this in the comfort that God has never forgotten them.

The day at St Alkmund's finished off with Shropshire Stories By Sal Tonge, and was enjoyed by the children and grown ups alike!



















WHITCHURCH CHRISTMAS LIGHT SWITCH ON SATURDAY 23RD NOVEMBER




